The California Gray Whale is the most ancient Baleen whale on Earth and the last surviving population of a species that once inhabited many of the world's oceans. The Gulf of Catalina Gray Whale Preservation & Education Foundation invites your students to participate in an exciting program that will assist in not only protecting and preserving this special species, but will teach them the importance of this species. They will also experience an opportunity to watch whales breach, fluke and spy hop, not to mention the added enjoyment of seeing pods of dolphins and playful sea lions!

Join our on-the-ocean expeditions that will educate and inspire your students. Two-hour field trips are science-based and geared towards data collection of whale statistics, including migratory patterns and reproductive rates. The data collection curriculum will include pre-collection activities in the classroom, the actual collection of data while on the ocean viewing the whales, and the presentation and study of findings. Each child also enjoys heart-healthy snacks while on board.
