At LIFE, guests have the unique opportunity to observe elephants in their natural habitat, deep in pristine cloud forest.

Your visit and support enables the community to continue protecting the vast forest that the elephants call home. We work in partnership with the community, developing a model for sustainable community based tourism while providing financial support to Karen mahouts so that they can continue to care for their elephants with the highest welfare standards in the forest surrounding the village.

# VISITING LIFE



During your stay you will be welcomed into the very center of a Karen community. Residing in the heart of the village, you can see for yourself how your host families live and work; sharing stories and creating lifelong memories. Karen people are proud of their ancient and fascinating culture and happily demonstrate their traditional skills such as; weaving brightly coloured cloth and basket making with you. Of course the highlight will be spending time with the elephants in our care.

## Sample Itinerary: Mountain Adventure

- Day 1 Drive up into the cloud forest to the top of a mountain, then settle in with your host family and enjoy a tour of the village followed by traditional Karen dinner.
- Day 2 Venture into stunning cloud forest to observe the elephants living in the freedom of their forest home and enjoy lunch with the mahouts in the forest.
- Day 3 Spend the day immersed in the community, learn how to weave traditional karen fabrics, sit with the men and try your hand at weaving a basket, or simply sit and drink a hot cup of mountain tea and learn about the region and its rich culture.
- Day 4 Wake up and have breakfast with your host family. Say your goodbyes and depart back to Mae Sot.

## Sample Itinerary: Volunteering

- Day 1 Depart Mae Sot after breakfast and drive up into the cloud forest. Spend the afternoon learning about the village and settle in with your host family.
- Day 2 Volunteer day with community members. Have breakfast with your host family, then Prepare yourself for a day out with members of the community, assisting with community based projects and learning about the culture.
- Day 3 Join the Mahouts as they venture out to find the elephants living in their beautiful forest habitat. Spend the day observing the elephants in their natural habitat.
- Day 4 Spend a second day volunteering on community projects working side by side with villagers
- Day 5 Enjoy one last day out with the elephants.
- Day 6 Wake up and have breakfast with your host family. Say your goodbyes and depart the village back to Mae Sot.



# ACCOMODATION

RELAX IN OUR BEAUTIFUL PRIVATE GUEST LODGE, OR IMMERSE YOURSELF IN VILLAGE LIFE IN A TRADITIONAL HOMESTAY.



*Option 1 – Our beautiful 3 bedroom guest lodge (+£100 GBP for the first room, £50 GBP for each additional room)*

*Our guest lodge has been built at the very top of the village, providing guests with the most incredible views over the village and out across the stunning forest and mountains.*

*The lodge is equip with comfortable beds, mosquito nets, a large communal area allowing you to soak up the surrounding views and a private bathroom with a western toilet and hot shower.*

*While you will not be staying with a host family, there will be a family allocated to cater for you during your stay, providing you with delicious traditional Karen dishes and hot drinks, your meals will be served at the family home.*



*Option 2 – Stay with a homestay (Included in base cost)*

*Staying with a host family is both welcoming and comfortable. Placing you in the very heart of village life, this option leaves you with a real sense of community living. Each homestay is different, but all host stunning views and friendly smiling faces – all of which will be eager to learn more about you, your family and your country, making you feel right at home in no time.*

*Your host family will provide you with bedding and a mosquito net. The Karen sleep on the floor and this is what is also provided for you, with the addition of a small mattress for additional comfort.*

*Bathrooms are clean and accessible with Asian style squat toilets or western toilet and traditional bucket showers – which are either refreshing or bracing depending on the time of year!*

*Your host family will cook for you throughout the duration of your stay, providing you with delicious traditional Karen dishes and the opportunity to sit together and be a part of their incredibly unique and special way of life.*



*Joining us at our LIFE project you are given a choice of accommodation, we ask that you inform us of your choice prior to your arrival*
